Part 1: How to make a data table.

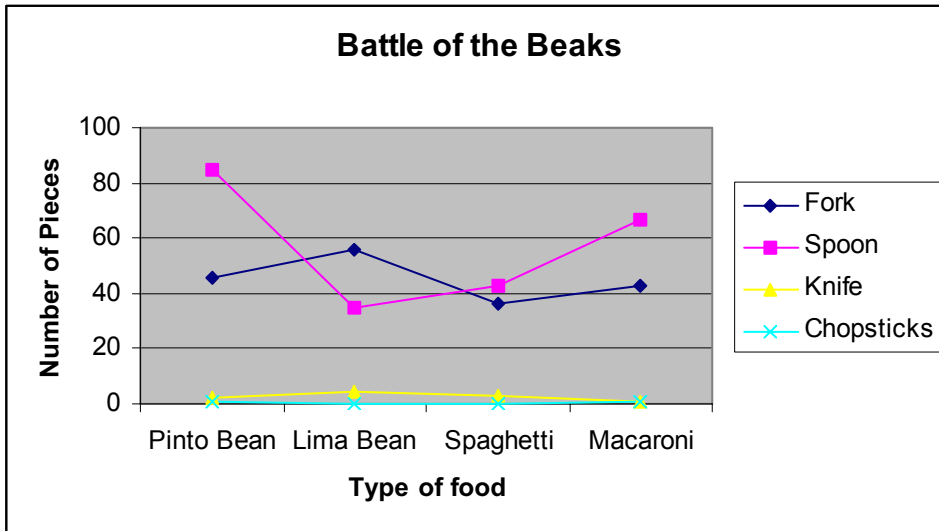
1. Take the average data from the second page of the Battle of the Beaks lab.
2. Using the columns and rows of Excel, label each row by utensil and each column by type of food.
3. Highlight the whole area of the data table.

Part 2: How to make a graph.

1. From the top bar, select insert, then chart.
2. Choose a type of graph (probably line or column).
3. Click next twice.
4. Give your graph a title.
5. Label the x-axis Type of Food.
6. Label your y-axis Number of Pieces.
7. Click next.
8. Click finish!
