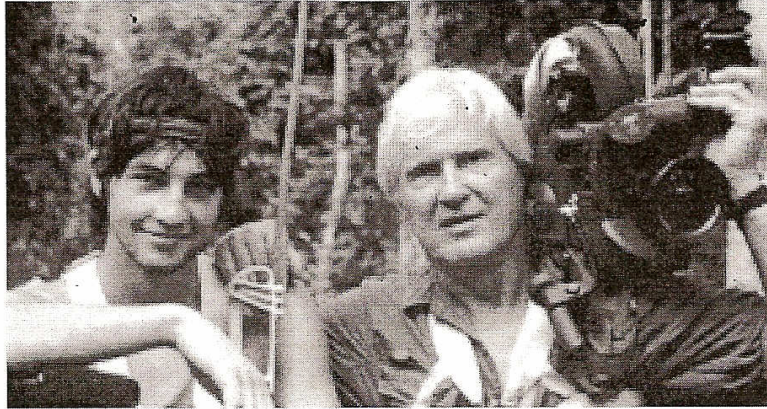


# Science Film Festival 10/22/09: EARTHLING



More than six years in the making, this extraordinary feature film is a moving tribute to the career of veteran filmmaker Wolfgang Bayer, by his son, Tristan, following in his father's footsteps. Bayer, with his family, revisits orangutans in Borneo, polar bears in the frozen Canadian Arctic, the dazzling jellyfish lakes of Palau, the Mexican mountain hideaways of the Monarch butterflies, and Yellowstone National Park, blending past footage with spectacular new footage shot by Tristan, trained by his father since childhood, and now ably making his own name in the world of wildlife cinematography.
