

How to Create Your Science Binder

A 3-ring Science Binder or a section of a binder is required.

How to set up your science binder/section:

Page 1: Title page that you create (see example to the right)

Page 2: How to create your Notebook, Science Department Policies on the back

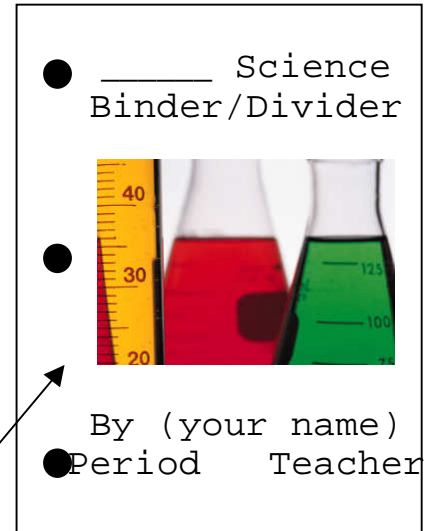
Page 3: Safety Rules

How to sort pages in your science binder/section:

Other pages in the notebook may include the following work grouped by UNIT in the order in which they were assigned:

- Lecture notes
- Homework
- Class work
- Quizzes and tests
- Lab write-ups

You may draw or cut out pictures to paste onto your title page.



Science binder/section tips:

Your binder/section is cumulative, so DO NOT throw anything away unless directed by your teacher.

Your binder/section may be graded periodically.

Your portfolio or final project may be created using work from your binder/section.

Your binder is a reflection of you – be sure you are PROUD of it!

Go through it regularly to keep it organized!
