

Trading Faces (of Famous Scientists)

Your assignment is to create a baseball card telling about the life of a famous scientist. This baseball card will show a picture of this scientist and outline the scientist's contribution to science.

The format to follow is on the next page. Use it as a rough draft (you will need to turn it in). Your actual baseball card should be the size of a 3 by 5 or 4 by 6 index card. Your card should be typed.

On the front of the card, you need to include:

- A picture of the scientist (drawn with color)
- The name of the scientist
- When this scientist lived and died
- Where this scientist lived or worked
- What type (or types) of science this person studied

On the back of the card, you need to include:

- 5 facts about the person or events from his or her life
- 5 contributions the scientist has made to benefit science.
(new ideas, new medicine, new products, new inventions, etc.)

As with all assignments, the project needs to be in your own words. You may not copy and paste words, sentences or paragraphs directly from the Internet. Your picture however can be from a website.

For your research, use at least 3 sources, at least one book or encyclopedia and at least one website. If you cannot find any of these, please see me.

For your bibliography, you need to look at page ____ in your agenda.

If you use a website, you must know the author of the website (either a person or an organization). Remember a search engine like Google.com is not a source. List the website where you actually got your information and

Your assignment will not be accepted without a bibliography!

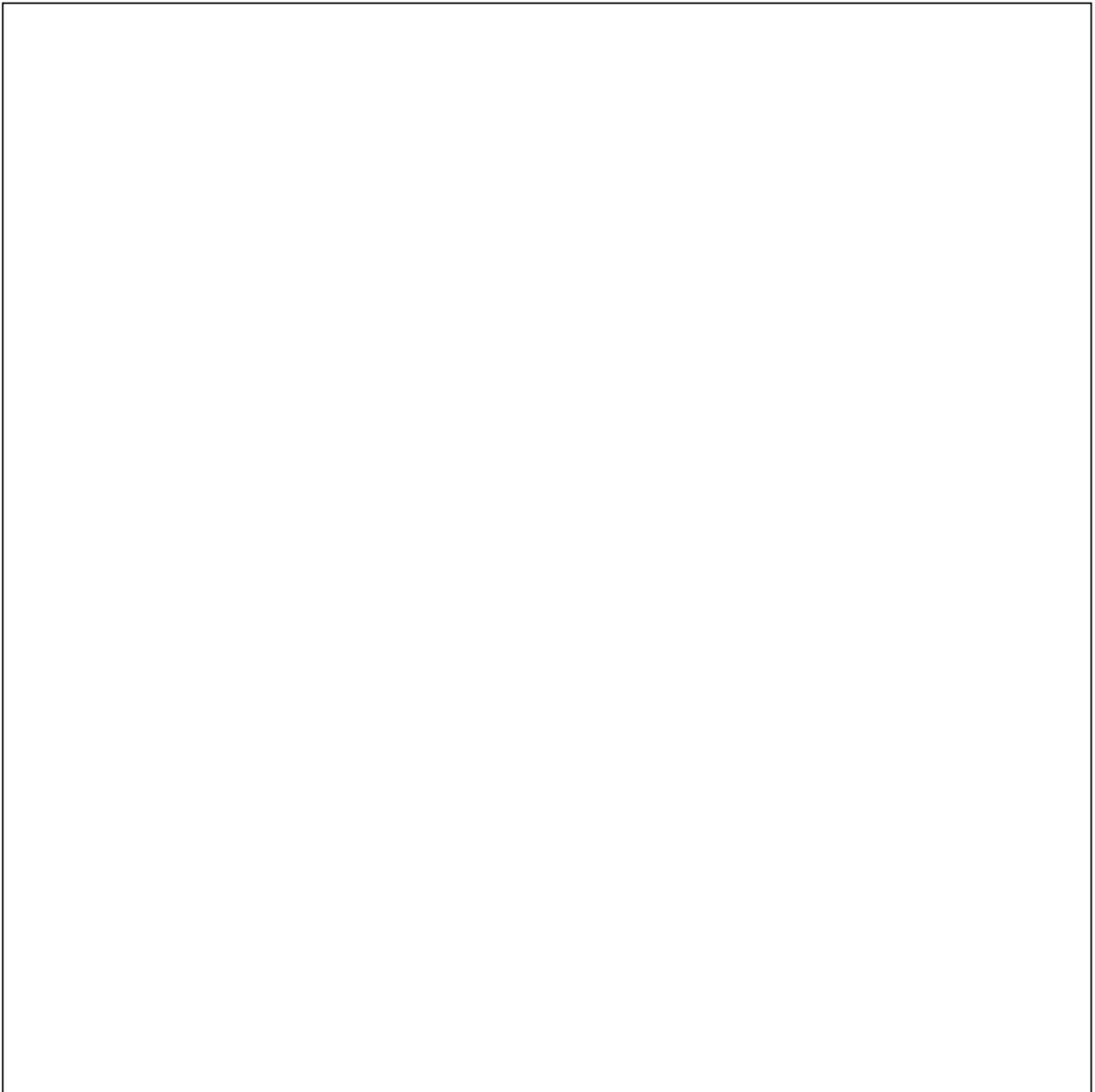
