I. Make vocabulary flips of the following words:

Trait- a characteristic

Gene-a set of instructions for a trait

Alleles-different forms of a trait

Dominant- a trait that will always show itself

Recessive- a trait that stays hidden unless both genes are recessive

Genotype- the genes present for a trait

Phenotype- the trait that shows up for the genes

Homozygous- an organism that has the same alleles for a gene

Heterozygous- an organism that has different alleles for a gene
