

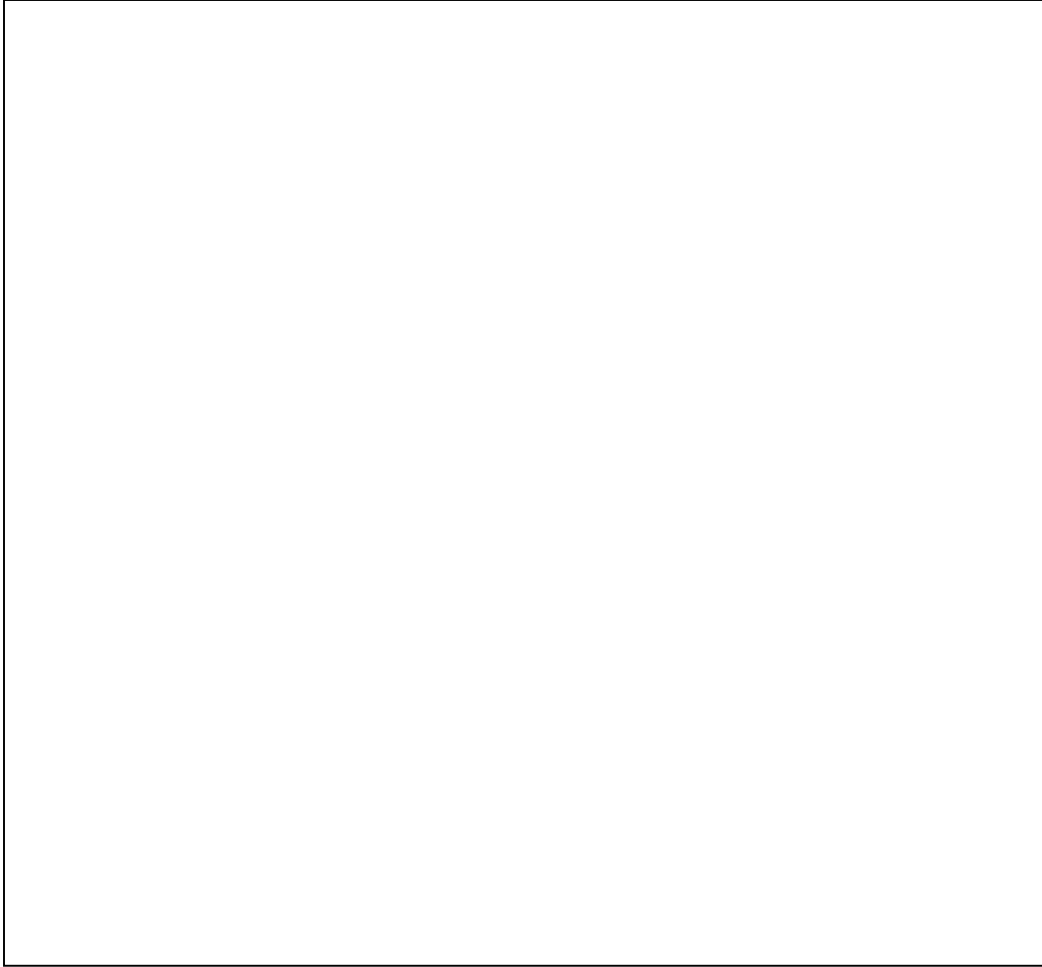

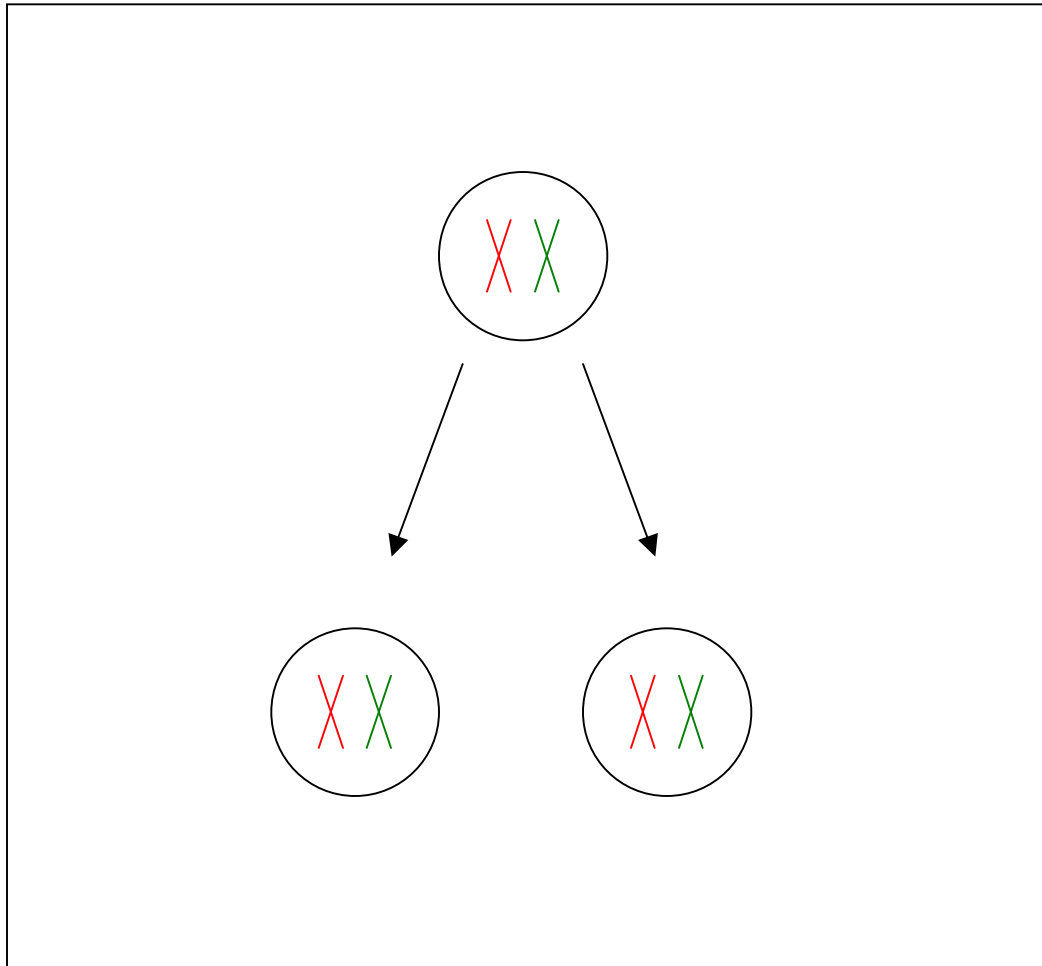

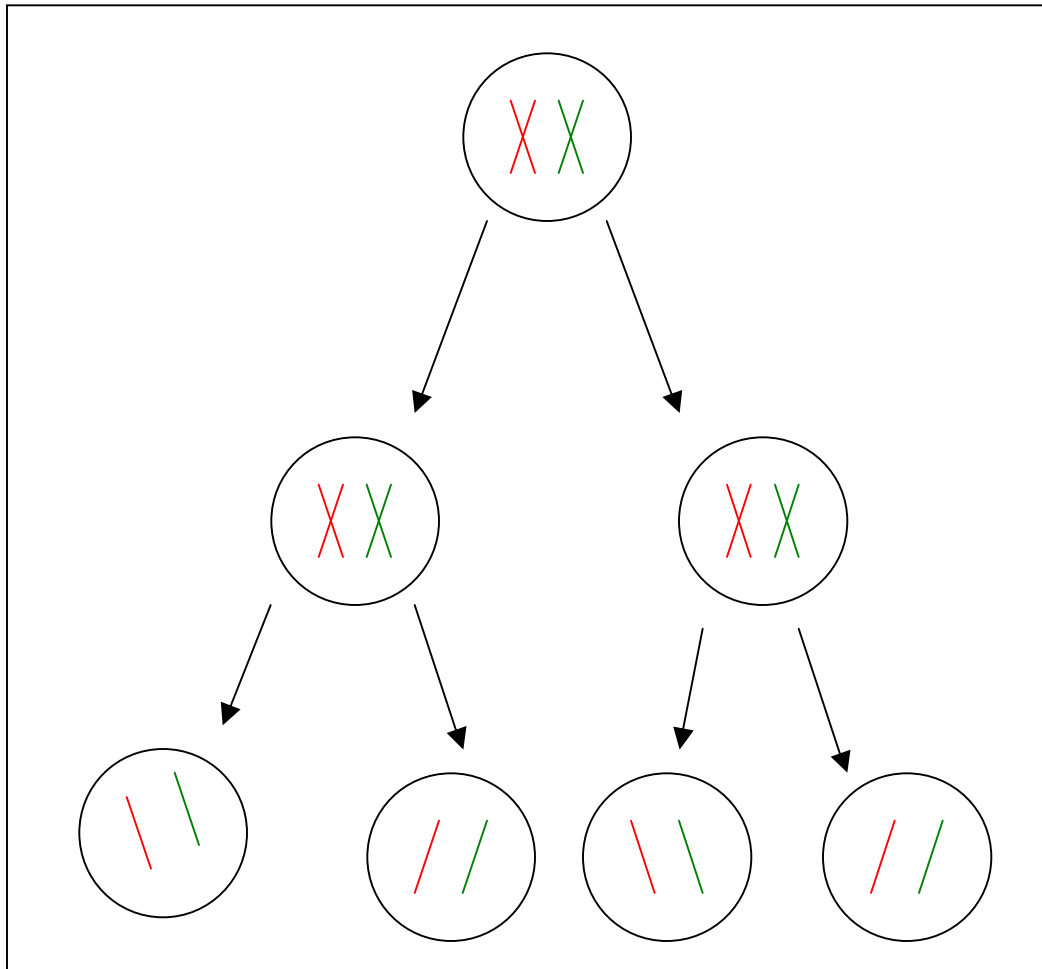

Meiosis

- Makes **4** cells.
- Makes a **sex** cell that will combine with another sex cell.
- The cell has **half** the number of chromosomes compared to the first cell.
- This is one part of **sexual** reproduction.
- These are the types of cells that do this: **Sperm Cells, Egg Cells, Pollen Cells**
